Understanding those elements that make for making better paintings, through the study of spatial illusion, composition, colour and mark-making. Idris Murphy guides you through the formal aspects of painting, with particular reference to contemporary landscape painting and the visual language that is critical to an understanding of painting.

Idris will present a series of brief lectures about landscape painting, the course will include one-to-one mentoring as well as group critiques and discussions.

Students can paint in any medium they wish. Bring your own materials, good walking shoes warm cloths and fun attitude.
