
Explore different approaches to understanding and drawing the land forms and ecology of an ecological farm. Over two days we will make drawings on paper, both as works in their own right, and also as part of a process towards making paintings in watercolour, oil and other mediums.

John Wolseley

John Wolseley was born in Somerset England in 1938. Since moving to Australia in 1978, he has immersed himself in the landscape, an approach which has given rise to a variety of different ways of collaborating with the land itself.

His large scale works on paper, watercolours and installations are often based around scientific themes like the movement of tides or sand-dunes or the forces of continental drift and evolution.

John Wolseley's work can be found in all state galleries in Australia and numerous public and private collections. In 2005 he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Science by Macquarie University, Sydney and the Emeritus Medal from the Visual Arts Board of the Australia Council. Lines for Birds - Poems and Paintings John Wolseley and Barry Hill UWA Press was published in 2010 He is represented in Sydney by Roslyn Oxley9 Gallery and in Melbourne by Australian Galleries.
