## Janet Laurence Perspective

Janet has put trees and the plight of nature at the heart of her life's work. She expresses the fragility of nature in her art practice, bridging ethical and environmental concerns. Janet's art considers the inseparability of all living things, she views this as an ecological quest.

Reflecting on the mutability of nature, science, memory and loss, Janet creates immersive environments offering us a deeply experiential and cultural relationship to the environment.

She explores the deep interconnection of life forms and ecologies to produce work driven by themes of alchemical transformation, history and perception that is distinctive, complex and beautiful.

Janet works in photography, sculpture, video and installation art. Her work has been included in major survey exhibitions and is regularly exhibited in Australia, Japan, Germany, Hong Kong and the UK.

A beautiful Riverina Beef cattle property running 6km along the Murrumbidgee River. The river flats and surrounding hills showcase the resilience of Australian landscape. The old River Red Gum trees line the river banks and Box trees and Kurrajongs show their resilience to the changing conditions. Owners Rebecca Gorman & John Sevier manage the property along the principals of Holistic Management to build a functioning ecosystem.
