Chatsworth House is a breathtaking historic property on the Hopkins River, known for its rolling hills, sandy loam soil, and thriving prime lamb and beef cattle farming. Established by John Moffat in the 1860s, it features a magnificent bluestone homestead, substantial stables, and men's quarters famously called the Long Room.

Accommodation & Dining

Attendees will stay at the **Shearers' Quarters, Cottage, Old Schoolhouse, or a neighbouring property**, all offering communal dining and shared bathroom facilities. Choose from queen or single shared rooms.



Artist & Non-Artist Experiences

Artists will enjoy an **immersive painting retreat**, while non-artists can explore the Grampians, farms, regional towns, and galleries - learning about land management at Chatsworth House.

Additional Opportunities

For those interested, there's an option to participate in **1.5-day art workshops and lectures**.

Food & Drink

All accommodation includes **breakfast, lunch, dinner, plus morning and afternoon tea**. BYO alcoholic and evening drinks for your stay.

Costs & Options

- Full Artist Package \$2,750: 6 nights, tuition & food
- Non-Artist Package \$1,450: 6 nights, twin-share & food

- Non-Artist Workshop Options \$330: 1.5-day or 3.5-day workshop sessions

Arrive **mid-afternoon on the first day** and wrap up **after breakfast on the final day** - five days of painting, exploring, and creativity at an iconic **Regenerative Farm** in Western Victoria, near the stunning Grampians.

Join renowned artist and educator Jon Cattapan for a five-day immersive workshop, set against the stunning regeneratively farmed landscape of Chatsworth House, east of the Grampians. This unique experience invites both serious artists and creative explorers to deepen their artistic practice, engage in meaningful discussions, and experiment with figurative techniques.

What to Expect

Creative Guidance - Jon Cattapan will lead daily sessions covering historical and contextual insights, one-on-one mentoring, and group tutorials on constructing figurative artworks within landscapes.

Inspiring Setting - The workshop draws inspiration from the thriving Hopkins River conservation areas, offering a chance to study ecology, regenerative farming, flora, and fauna.

Excursions & Learning - Enjoy trips to the Grampians and WAMA Wildlife Art Museum, plus insights into land management practices at Chatsworth House.

Creative Exchange - Engage with fellow artists and experiment with new approaches to representing people in environments, drawing from Australian art traditions.

Accommodation & Travel

Stay at Chatsworth House in historic quarters, with shared bathrooms and communal dining. Options include queen and single shared rooms.

Getting there: Self-drive, train, or domestic flights to Hamilton.
